Youth summer sessions will start up the week of June 1st. Please watch your email for times/days for High School and Middle School.

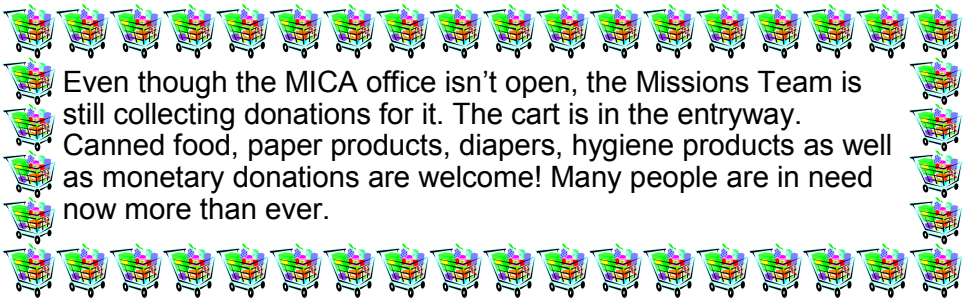
HAVE YOU REGISTERED YET?
